

# 2010 Plastic Round-up Materials Sort List

**PRE-SORT CLEAN & DRY** plastics into these categories:  
**Soft Plastic, Hard Plastic, Nursery Pots/Trays**

## **Soft Plastics**

dry cleaning bags  
grocery bags  
bubble wrap and shrink wrap  
freezer bags  
zip lock bags  
Mylar  
cereal liners  
six pack rings  
potato chip bags  
tarps (remove grommets in advance)  
greenhouse film  
fertilizer and seed bags  
drip tape (preferably bagged separately)  
Visquene (no mud chunks, dust OK)  
woven landscape fabric (no mud chunks)  
hairnets, polypropylene, elastic OK  
election signs (flimsy, bag material, no stakes)

## **Nursery Plastics**

nursery potting trays/flats  
nursery pots of all sizes  
potting 4-packs & 6-packs

## **Hard Plastics**

all plastics with numbers  
baling twine (preferably bag separately)  
plastic strapping (no metal)  
buckets (remove metal handles)  
clam shells/to-go containers  
bottle caps and drink lids  
DVD's, CD's and their cases (bag separately)  
VHS, 8-track and audio tapes (bag separately)  
straws  
lawn and patio furniture  
toys (remove all metal parts)  
pet igloos  
laundry baskets  
synthetic wine corks  
drip irrigation components – no PVC  
election signs (corrugated plastic, no stakes)  
cups – colored or clear  
pond liners (molded, not rubber)

## **Items *NOT* Accepted – these items will be rejected!**

***You will be asked to haul away any unacceptable items***

### **NO DIRTY PLASTIC!**

- NO Styrofoam blocks, peanuts, food trays or egg cartons
- NO "compostable" plastic or #PLA 7
- NO PVC pipe
- NO vinyl
- NO above ground swimming pools/liners
- NO food contaminated plastic
- NO foam or rubber
- NO small toys with metal in them
- NO plastic with metal or electronics
- NO spray bottle nozzles and pumps with metal springs (remove spring)
- NO containers with any chemical residue
- NO Latex, Nitrile or rubber gloves
- NO coolers
